**Court Announces Interim  
Judicial Assignments in Response to  
Court Commissioner Retirements**

Presiding Judge James R. Ritchie has announced the following changes to judicial assignments in the month of August. He has authorized Court Commissioners Randolph E. Heubach and Beverly K. Wood to switch assignments effective August 20, 2012. Beginning on this date, Commissioner Heubach will preside over misdemeanor matters in Department M and Commissioner Wood will move to Department O to preside over family law cases. This transition is being made in August to accommodate advance planning for Commissioner Heubach's announced retirement in the Spring of 2013.

In addition, Court Commissioner Harvey E. Goldfine will retire on August 30, 2012. Beginning on August 31<sup>st</sup>, Judge Terrence R. Boren will preside over juvenile matters as well as probate conservatorships, guardianships and mental health proceedings for at least the remainder of the calendar year.

Over the next few months, the court will review judicial assignment rotations for the two-year cycle beginning on January 1, 2013. Presiding Judge Ritchie will announce additional changes, if any, when that review has been concluded.
